

Assembling the Profilecutter




WARNING

The blade is extremely sharp and must not be touched on the cutting edge. Always attach the supplied blade guard!



- Remove all components from the tool case
- Attach the base plate to the cutting unit using the two 80 x 5 mm mounting screws
- Attach the lever to the cutting unit using the 45 x 5 mm mounting screw
- Tighten all screws by hand - snug, but not over-tightened
- Insert the cutting fence into one of the three positioning





Cutting

Preparation

- Position the cutting fence as needed (left/right 15° / 22.5° / 30° / 45° / 90°). Unlock the cutting unit using the locking pin and remove the blade guard.
- Disengage the cutting tool by removing the locking pin and take off the blade guard

Perfect Cut in 2 Steps



Separation Cut (Rough Cut)



Finish Cut (Precise Cut)

Finish Cut (Precise Cut)

- Place the profile to be cut flush against the cutting fence on the support surface, positioning it 2–3 mm before the desired mark
- Separation Cut: Press the handle all the way down until the material is completely cut through
- Finish Cut: Align the profile exactly at the mark and make a second, precise cut along the same line

Angle Cuts

- Position the cutting fence to the desired angle. Place the profile to be cut flush against the cutting fence on the support surface, positioning it 2–3 mm before the desired mark
- Separation Cut: Press the handle fully down until the material is completely cut through
- Finish Cut: Align the profile exactly at the mark and make a second, precise cut along the same line

WARNING

Maintain control of the handle. Do not let the handle snap back after the cut!



Failure to follow the safety instructions below can result in serious injury!

Safety Rules for the Profilecutter

- This instruction manual must be read and understood before using the Profilecutter
- If anything is unclear, please consult your dealer or contact Döllken Profiles for assistance
- Stay alert and never operate the tool under the influence of drugs, alcohol, or medication
- · Keep your work area clean and free of waste
- Keep children and unauthorized persons away from the working area
- Operate the tool only on a solid, stable surface with a secure footing
- The lever is spring-loaded and returns automatically Always keep the swing area of the lever clear
- Use the correct tool. This device is designed exclusively for cutting original Döllken profiles
- The blade must always be sharp. A dull blade leads to unclean cuts and significantly increases the amount of force required
- · Replace dull blades promptly
- Avoid any contact with the blade. Never place your hands under the blade during operation or transport
- Always attach the blade guard when changing the blade or when the device is not in use
- Engage the locking pin when the device is not in use and during transport or assembly
- Maintain the cutter properly. Keep the blade sharp and clean at all times
- Follow the instructions for replacing accessories
- Do not modify the tool. Any modifications not described in this manual may affect functionality and create hazardous situations
- Use only recommended accessories. Using unsuitable accessories can cause accidents or injuries
- · Never leave the cutter unattended
- While the Profilecutter does not generate dust, it may produce small waste pieces. These must not be ingested

Blade Replacement



- Always attach the blade guard before starting.
 Use an Allen key to remove the three screws
- Hold the blade firmly at both ends and carefully remove it from the blade holder
- When installing the new blade, make sure to position the flat side of the blade toward the support surface
- The blade must be fully inserted until it stops and securely fastened again with all three screws
